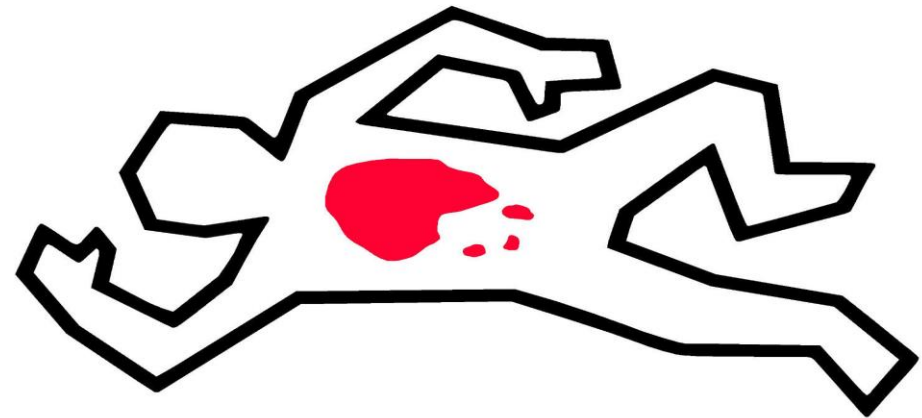
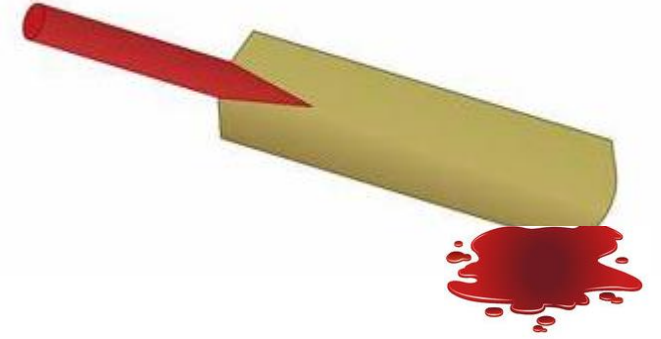



- Graham Dawson
- Trained Olympic athletes for over 8 years
- Has a reputation of dating the athletes he trains
- Had a relationship with Anna 18 months ago

# Suspect 2



- Julia Taylor
- Has been dating Graham for 14 months
  - Very strong and athletic
  - Favourite colour is green
- Once dated Sonia's brother. The two are still said to be good friends.
- Likes casinos and betting
- Worked at Sports Direct

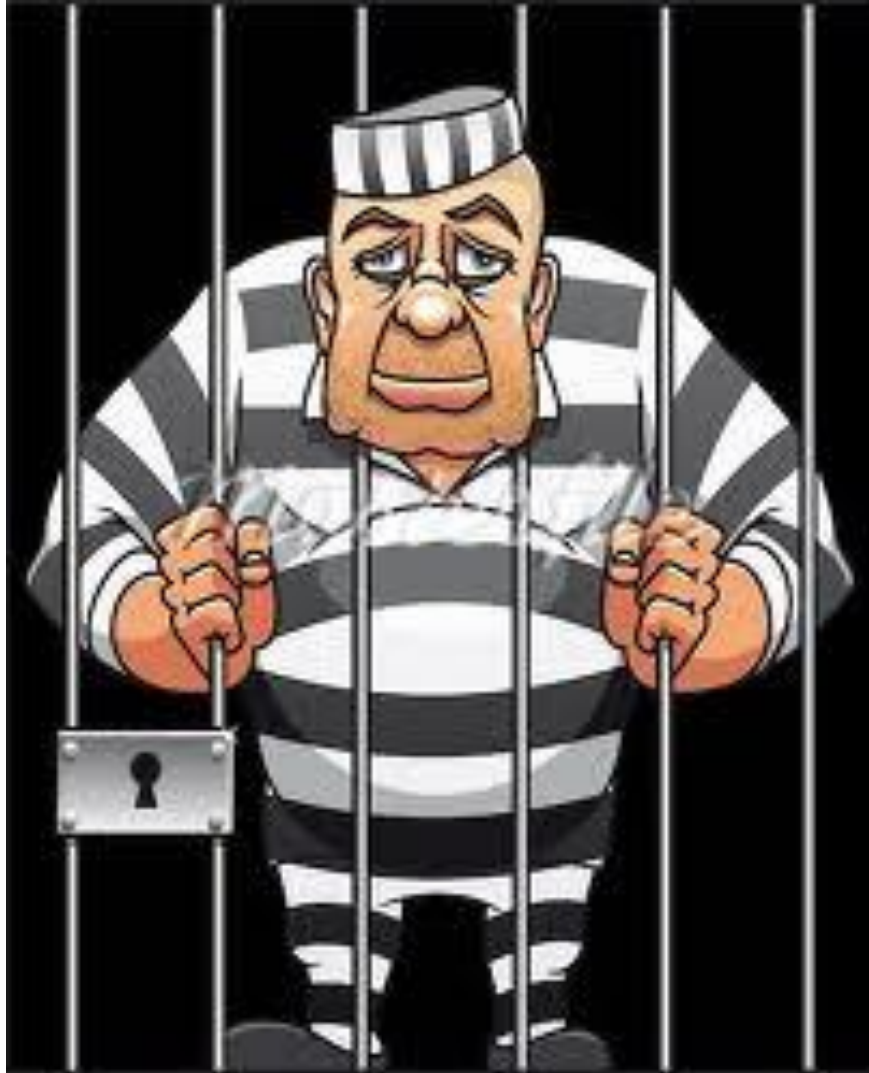


# Suspect 3



- Sonia Smithson
- Anna's team mate
- The two have trained together since they were twelve
- Been second in 12 of her 15 races; Anna came first 14 out of these 15
- Brother used to date Hannah

# Suspect 4



- Vincent Maker
- Convicted of murder and theft in 1992
- Escaped from prison on the night Anna was killed
- He was sentenced to 25 years
- Police have warned the public not to approach him. They believe he is very dangerous.

PC Drewry interviewing Albert Lawson (eye-witness)

Date: 23/07/19

Time: 3.34pm

PC: Can you tell me where you found the body?

AL: Outside The Emporium. It was around 11 o'clock.

PC: And why were you outside The Emporium at this time?

AL: I was on duty. Since the athletes arrived last week, security has been stepped up.

PC: So you work for the Clitheroe Games?

AL: Indeed. Worked with them since 1989. As a security guard. I love it. Well, I loved it until all this happened. I can't get the picture of her out of my mind.

PC: Let's focus on the facts. You found her at 11 o'clock. What state was she in?

AL: She was cold. She looked as though she'd been out. She wasn't in her tracksuit like she usually was.

PC: Can you tell me what she was wearing?

AL: A jacket. It was late you see... She was wearing a jacket. And she was wearing jeans.

PC: Did you see anyone else near the scene?

AL: No. No I didn't. Nobody I spoke to that night had seen anyone. Everything was normal.

PC: So there's nothing else you can tell me?

AL: I didn't say that. Anna had always been nice and polite. She always had a smile on her face. I decided to check the CCTV and saw someone...

PC: And..?

AL: And I couldn't really make out who it was. They had their hood up. At first, Anna smiled and waved so she obviously knew them but the other person didn't wave back. There was a little scuffle. Anna fell to the floor. The hooded figure pulled something large from a bag they were carrying and lunged at Anna.

PC: Keep going...

AL: And then they ran off in a panic. A purse was left on the floor. The attacker didn't take it and there was over-£50 in there. There was a receipt in there, too. I found that strange. Anna's jean pocket has also been torn off during the scuffle, so whoever attacked her clearly overpowered her.
