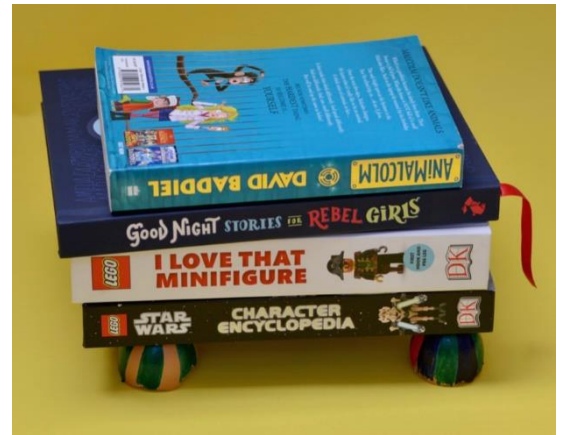
Calling all budding scientists, here are some exciting experiments that you can try for yourselves at home!

## Summer holiday cancelled? Stuck in rainy England for a classic 'British Summer?'

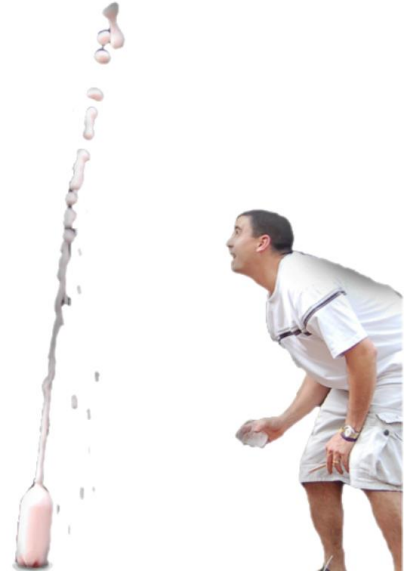
Don't worry - you can still get your ice cream fix! Make it inside and enjoy it in front of the television whilst someone BBQs in the rain.
